Roll was taken with Councilors Sally Thompson, Katie Zmuda, Wayne Kostur, John Manderscheid and Councilor Gene Wright being present. City Recorder, Michelle Fox, and 1 guest were also present. Mayor Schroeder led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **Business from the Public:**

**AMA** - Katie Zmuda reported for the Main Street Association. The Christmas Bazaar was very well attended. AMA received a \$9,000 grant to be used for the electrical project. The year was a success but they are still looking for new members.


