City Recorder, Michelle Fox and two guest were also present. Mayor Schroeder led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

## Business from the Public:

Work on the mechanical room at the pool will be starting in the next week or two.

She emphasized that no historical information about the City of Athena has been discarded from the library. Stephanie has also been rearranging the library for more efficiency.
