ORDINANCE NO. 440

AN ORDINANCE MAKING GARBAGE SERVICE CHARGES A LIEN UPON THE PROPERTY SERVED; AND PROVIDING FOR THE TERMINATION OF GARBAGE CHARGES UPON RECEIPT OF NOTICE OF DISCONTINUANCE OF WATER SERVICE.

The City of Athena, Oregon ordains as follows:

Section 1. Garbage Service Charges to Be a Lien Upon Property Served. All garbage service charges made by the City of Athena shall be a lien upon the property served until full payment therefore has been received by the city.

Section 2. Termination of Garbage Service Charges. In the event that the property served by the City of Athena for garbage collection purposes shall become vacant and require no further service, the garbage service charges shall terminate as to said property upon receipt by the city of a notice to the effect that said premises are vacant and requesting termination of water service. Proof of such vacancy must be furnished the city upon request, and failure to furnish such proof shall set aside the said termination.

Section 3. Services Contracted. If the city elects to contract the garbage services out to a qualified agency, and agency is responsible for collecting fees, then the agency is responsible for past due accounts according to their policy.
