TENNIS COURT ORDINANCE NO. 530

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE MUNICIPAL TENNIS COURTS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The City of Athena, Oregon ordains as follows:

Section 1. <u>Footwear Required</u>. No person shall go or permit any minor child under his care, custody and control to go upon the playing surfaces of the municipal tennis courts without proper footwear. Proper footwear shall be soles, bare feet or stocking feet. No leather soled shoes or shoes with cleated, barred soles, including rubber cleated athletic type shoes, shall be worn on said courts.

Section 2. <u>Use of Courts</u>. Said municipal tennis courts shall be used only for the playing of the games of tennis or instruction therein. No person shall use or permit any minor child under his care, custody and control to use any bicycle, tricycle, skateboard, roller skates, pogo stick or any other wheeled vehicle or sports or other equipment of any kind or nature upon said courts.

Section 3. Penalty. Any person who violates this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined as determined by referendum, and in addition there to may be required to pay all costs incurred in repairing any damage to said tennis courts which may have resulted from said violation.
