ORDINANCE NO. 610

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION AND MOVEMENT OF BICYCLES WITHIN THE CITY OF ATHENA, OREGON; PROVIDING REQUIREMENTS AS TO THE EQUIPMENT ON SUCH BICYCLES; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The City of Athena, Oregon ordains as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to roller blade, roller skate or to ride or operate any bicycle, skateboard, or scooter, upon the sidewalks of Main Street within the City of Athena, Oregon at any and all times.

Section 2. Every person riding or operating a bicycle upon any street, alley or other public place within the corporate limits of the City of Athena, Oregon, shall at all times observe the rules, regulations and statutes of the State of Oregon applicable to such bicycles, incorporated in this ordinance and made a part thereof by reference thereto.

Section 3. No operator of a bicycle shall leave such bicycle lying or standing in such a manner that shall hinder or impede pedestrian or vehicular traffic upon the sidewalks, paths, streets or alleys within the corporate limits of the City of Athena, but shall take proper care to see that such bicycle is so placed to avoid annoyance and danger of accident during his absence from it.

Section 4. All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
