ORDINANCE NO.820

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT SKIRTS BE PLACED ON ALL TRAILER HOMES AS A CONDITION OF ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS; PRESCRIBING A PENALTY; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 310.

The city of Athena, Oregon ordains as follows:

Section 1. Skirts Required on Trailer Homes. The owners or occupants of any trailer home or mobile home set up for occupancy within the city of Athena shall (supply it) with an adequate skirt around the base thereof within 60 days after such trailer or mobile home is placed upon the property.

Section 2. Exceptions. This ordinance shall not apply to transient trailers temporarily installed in any licensed trailer court within the city limits, nor shall it apply to vacant trailers which are merely stored upon such property.

Section 3. Penalty. Any person, owner or occupant of any such mobile home who violates any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined according to the fee schedule. Each day during which the condition is allowed to continue shall be deemed to be a separate violation.

Section 4. Repealer. Ordinance No. 310 of the city of Athena is hereby repealed.
