# THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE ATHENA CITY COUNCIL

July 8, 2021

<u>Attendance:</u> Mayor Becky Schroeder called the regular meeting of the Athena City Council to order at 6:00 pm. Roll was taken with Councilors Katie Zmuda, Wayne Kostur, Sally Thompson, and Gene Wright present. Councilor Jesse Bonifer was absent. City Recorder Michelle Fox and four guests were also in attendance. Mayor Schroeder led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### Business from the Public:

Athena Mainstreet Association (AMA): April Vorhauer Flatt with the Athena Mainstreet Association updated the Council on their events. Community Night Out will be July 30, on Main Street from 6:00-9:00. Due to popular demand, Tuesday Market will continue through August. April brought up a concern about a couple safety hazards on Main Street. One being the tree by the Stahl Building and the tree by Napa causing the sidewalks to buckle. Councilor Wright would like a list of these safety hazards.

<u>Consent Agenda:</u> A motion was made and seconded to approve the council meeting minutes of the 6/10/21 meeting, the financial statements, and bills. Motion carried 4-0.
